European Commission has published on November 30, 2016 its European **Defence Action Plan** which further to a factsheet encompasses also a set of documents which are detailed below.



European Commission published a set of documents related to the **Defence** & Security Procurement Directive 2009/81/EC: the 2016 report on implementation of the Directive, the 2016 evaluation report of the Directive, and an update Government to Government guideline.



European Commission published a set of documents related to the Intra Community transfer Directive 2009/43/EC: the 2016 Report Evaluation of Directive 2009/43/EC, the 2016 Recommendation on the harmonisation of the General Transfer Licence for armed forces under Directive 2009/43/EC (Transfers Licence), and the 2016 Recommendation on the harmonisation of the General Transfer Licence for recipients certified under Directive 2009/43/EC (Transfers Licence).



European Commission also published the report and recommendations of the Advisory expert group on cross-border access for SMEs to defence and security contracts.

EDA SME study: EDA just released the Executive Summary of the "Analysis of defence-related SMEs' composition in EU". The study included three main tasks designed to enhance the visibility of SMEs participating in the defencerelated supply chains across pMS, establish key performance indicators to measure SME participation, and identify best practices in optimising SME participation across the US DoD.
