EDA carried out the study “[Medical Support to Light Footprint Operations](#)” which objective was to keep the quality of medical support at the highest possible level for missions of smaller scale.



The **second T&E Community Days (TECD)** Conference in Vienna (24-27 of April), which was hosted by the Austrian MOD and the Wirtschaftskammer Österreich, focussed on impact of the implementation of the EU Global Strategy on the future development opportunities for T&E Centres. There was broad agreement amongst delegates that the existing European Network of T&E Centres should develop a ‘capacity to respond quickly’ through an integrated approach linking systematically T&E to standardisation and harmonised certification requirements.
