Subject: Ex-ante publicity notice for the negotiated procedure 17.CSD.NP3.427 "Service Framework Contract for the provision of coffee machines & coffee to EDA"

To whom it may concern

The European Defence Agency (EDA) will shortly launch a call for tenders for the award of the above mentioned middle value contract.

Should you be interested in being invited in the above mentioned call for tenders, please follow the instructions below.

In order to help you assess whether the envisaged contract is of your interest, the following information is hereby communicated.

Outline description of the envisaged contract

Subject matter of the contract	EDA intends to launch a call for tender in view of concluding a contract for the provision of (an estimated) four "bean-to-cup" coffee machines and coffee supplies "beans" for its offices in Brussels. To that end, the present notifications, to which interested economic operators are invited to respond, is published.			

The so called "bean-to-cup" coffee machines are the coffee machines with incorporated coffee grinderable to grind the beans and dispense the fresh coffee at the touch of a button.

By the provision of bean-to-cup coffee machines, EDA understands:

- The supply of 4 bean-to-cup coffee machines out of which 3 bean-to-cup coffee machines are to be equipped with with integrated water tanks and 1 bean-to-cup coffee machine which can be connected to water supply (tap).
- 2. The supply of coffee beans
- 3. The necessary preventive and support maintenance including all products necessary for the proper and continuous functioning of the machines.

Participation in the negotiated procedure

Participation in EDA's public procurement procedures is open on equal terms to all natural and legal persons coming within the scope of the EU Treaties. When applying the rules of access to the market, it is the country where the tenderer is established which is to be considered. As regards a natural person, it is the State in which the person has his domicile.

EDA procurement procedures are not covered by the WTO Multilateral Government Procurement Agreement (GPA). Tenderers established in third countries (non-EU countries) do not have the right to participate in procurement procedures unless international agreements in the field of public procurement grant them the right to do so. In case there is no such agreement, or the agreement does not apply to the kind of contracts put out to tender, tenderers of third countries are not entitled to participate.

The relevant international agreements in the field of public procurement are the Stabilization and Association Agreements (SAA) and the European Economic Area Agreement (EEA). Currently, the following countries have signed and ratified the above Agreements and therefore economic operators established in Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, FYROM, Albania, Montenegro, Serbia, Kosovo, Bosnia and Herzegovina also have the right to participate in EDA's public procurement procedures.

The contracting authority reserves the right to also invite economic operators not included in the list of interested economic operators who responded to this ex-ante publicity.

Only the candidates invited by the contracting authority to participate in this procurement

procedure will be admissible.

This publicity is in no way binding for the EDA. The EDA's contractual obligation commences

only upon signature of the contract with the successful tenderer.

Submission of an expression of interest implies acceptance of receiving the invitation to

tender by electronic means. It is the tenderer's responsibility to provide a valid e-mail address

together with their contact details in the Reply Form and to check their e-mail regularly.
