Success for the 1<sup>st</sup> R&T project assessed by the competent Managing Authority to access ESIF under the support that EDA launched in 2015. The project develops a composite material with high-impact resistance, allowing for both civilian (aeronautical sector) and defence (bulletproof equipment) applications. ESIF will fund almost 70%. The project consortium is led by a Portuguese SME with a research centre, a university and the Ministry of Defence as members: this is the 1<sup>st</sup> time that a MoD is directly funded by ESIF.
