National EDA Member States' Defence Data 2013

This document provides national defence data of the 27 EDA Member States for the years 2012-2013. For Croatia, which became the 27th EDA Member State on 1 July 2013, only 2013 data is available.

All data is provided by the Ministries of Defence of the EDA Member States, based on the list of indicators approved by the Agency's Ministerial Steering Board in 2007, and all financial indicators refer to actual expenditure.

The structure of the document follows that of the **Defence Data 2013 booklet**, where the indicators are grouped under four sections, represented in the headings:

- I. <u>General</u>: macro-economic data to show how defence budgets relate to GDP and overall government spending.
- **II.** Reform: (a) personnel numbers to show the ratio between the military and civilians employed in defence and (b) major categories of defence budget spending personnel; investment, including research and development (R&D)/research and technology (R&T); operation and maintenance (O&M) and others to show what defence budgets are spent on.
- **III.** European collaboration: for defence equipment procurement and R&T, to show to what extent the EDA MS are investing together.
- **IV.** <u>Deployability</u>: military deployed in crisis management operations to show the ratio between deployments and total military personnel; and costs of deployed operations.

Note: In the cases when national data is restricted or not available, blank spaces appear in the graphs.











% Change in Defence Expenditure, 2012-2013






Defence Expenditure as % of GDP





Defence Expenditure as % of Overall Government Expenditure








Defence Expenditure per Capita

(EUR)











Total Number of Military Personnel






% Change in the Number of Military Personnel, 2012-2013






Total Number of Civilian Personnel






% Change in the Number of Civilian Personnel, 2012-2013






Proportion of Military and Civilian Personnel, 2013






Number of Internal Security Military Forces








Total Defence Expenditure and Investment (Equipment Procurement and R&D) per Military, 2013






% Change in Total Defence Expenditure per Military, 2012-2013












Personnel Expenditure




% Change in Personnel Expenditure, 2012-2013






Personnel Expenditure as % of Total Defence Expenditure






Operation and Maintenance Expenditure

(million EUR)






% Change in Operation and Maintenance Expenditure, 2012-2013






Operation and Maintenance Expenditure as % of Total Defence Expenditure






Defence Investment (Equipment Procurement and R&D)




Defence Investment as % of Total Defence Expenditure






Defence Equipment Procurement Expenditure











Defence Equipment Procurement as % of Total Defence Expenditure









Defence R&D Expenditure as % of Total Defence Expenditure











Defence R&T Expenditure as % of Total Defence Expenditure




Infrastructure/Construction Expenditure

(million EUR)






% Change in Infrastructure/Construction Expenditure, 2012-2013






Infrastructure/Construction Expenditure as % of Total Defence Expenditure






Defence Expenditure "Outsourced"

(million EUR)






% Change in Defence Expenditure "Outsourced", 2012-2013





Defence Expenditure "Outsourced" as % of Total Defence Expenditure
















% Change in Collaborative Defence Equipment Procurement, 2012-2013






Collaborative Equipment Procurement as % of Total Equipment Procurement






% Change in European Collaborative Defence Equipment Procurement, 2012-2013






European Collaborative Equipment Procurement as % of Total Collaborative Equipment Procurement





Collaborative Defence R&T Expenditure






% Change in Collaborative Defence R&T Expenditure, 2012-2013





Collaborative Defence R&T as % of Total Defence R&T










European Collaborative Defence R&T Expenditure




% Change in European Collaborative Defence R&T, 2012-2013







European Collaborative Defence R&T as % of Total Collaborative Defence R&T













Average Number of Troops Deployed






% Change in Average Number of Troops Deployed, 2012-2013






Average Number of Troops Deployed as % of Total Military Personnel






Operations Costs (Deployed)

(million EUR)






% Change in Operations Costs (Deployed), 2012-2013





Operations Costs (Deployed) as % of Total Defence Expenditure





Total Number of Deployable (Land) Forces






% Change in Total Deployable (Land) Forces, 2012-2013






Deployable (Land) Forces as % of Total Military Personnel






% Change in Sustainable (Land) Forces, 2012-2013
