Under the European Defence Fund (EDF) 2022, the grant for the Development Action call on the topic 'European command and control system' was signed on 28 June 2024. The awarded project, called EC2, is led by INDRA (Spain). The consortium encompasses a total of 19 participants from 13 countries. The project, which has a duration of 24 months, will receive an EU grant of roughly €30 million.

<p>EC2 will be a critical enabler for CSDP operations and missions, providing the EU with a multi-domain command and control solution. It will empower strategic direction with unprecedented knowledge of the situation, permit to speed up decision cycles to machine speed, assist to perform truly collaborative and concurrent planning processes and allow to conduct and execute in real-time CSDP missions and operations with minimal non-value-added tasks.</p> <p>More specifically, EC2 will:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Facilitate C2 functions for the full spectrum of CSDP missions and operations, including rescue to peace making, including, but not limited to, humanitarian, disarmament, advisory and stabilization tasks.</li> <li>2. Contribute to enhance the interoperability among MS and between EU and MS.</li> <li>3. Connect the different actors at the strategic level ensuring proper security to increase the information exchange and ease of use in the different security environments where EC2 must operate.</li> <li>4. Provide the CSDP chain of command with the required tools to conduct EU missions and operations.</li> </ol>
