


How did we introduce the CAMO?



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- Step 1: gather data on organisation
 - Visits to different CAMO's
 - CAME requirements analysis
 - ARC analysis
- Step 2:whiteboard exercise
 - Identify what is already done
 - Centralized vs Decentralized
 - Fill the gaps
 - Fit principle to the structure
- Step 3: develop CAMO
 - Assign tasks in the current structure








What was the first attempt?








Why was it a flawed design?



After the BMAA audit by OSAC

- The concept had some issues, misunderstanding of the functionalities of the CAMO
- Mix up between functions known in Belgian Defence, DO functions and actual CAMO functions
- The structural and functionnal relationships within Belgian Defence didn't match with the functional relationships between DO-CAMO-MO
- The ARC's can't be approved by the CAMO
 Conflicting interests between BMAA
 and Comopsair








How did we correct it?

The CAMO organisation



- After the BMAA audit by OSAC
 - The organization functions were reviewed
 - DGMR Sys-A
 - Comopsair A4
 - Role of the BMAA Maintenance and Operator Branch remains
 - Issues ARCs, A4.30 is the right office
 - Custodian of the BMAR-M
 - Approves the CAMO / CAME








What has it become?

The CAMO organisation



BMAA Maint&Opr branch

- → Pool of Quaiified AW Review staff (ARS)
- → Deliverance of ARC by BMAA (prolongation by CAMO)
- → ARS may not be implicated in Maint Mgt and execution (so not in BMAR M and 145)
- → As ACC is "head of Operating Organisation" → COA staff to survey the "CAMO contract" is advised
- → BMAA Maint&Opr branch as "custodian" of the BMAR M and deliverance of a CAMO approval
- + At execution level, not at policy level
- + Quality department





Key take aways!



- Fully understand the importance of the CAMO and its assigned roles and responsibilities towards:
 - Operator
 - Maintenance Organisation
 - Design Organisation
 - Authorities
- A program manager / office might be closer to a CAMO function than a DO function.
- An external expert view before implementing such a project can prevent a lot of trouble.
- Think about how to handle the Airworthiness Reviews, be cautious not to mix up responsibilities.







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
