EMAR implementation as close as possible of the requirement

> EMAR application on the concerned weapon systems

➤ Implementation of the recognition in national documents (MOE etc.)

➤ Think interoperability at all level from the Mechanic to the Chief of Air Force

International

level

- > Full mutual recognition of Authorities
- > Avoid discrepancies between national rules
 - * Harmonise the national rules
 - * Make EMAR the European rule! Not the requirement...

- > Start with volunteers countries, with common interest...
