Cyber defence conference – The International Conference on Cyber Defence – Building a Rapid Response will be held in the Central Military Club, Sofia, Bulgaria, on 13-14 June 2018. This event is co-organised by the Bulgarian EU Presidency and the European Defence Agency (EDA). A call for papers on topics of interest has been <u>published here</u>. <u>Defence Conference</u> – The 9<sup>th</sup> International Scientific Conference will take place in Plovdiv, Bulgaria, on 31 May 2018 as part of the official calendar of the Bulgarian Presidency of the Council of the European Union. The conference will be held in the framework of the 13<sup>th</sup> International Defence Equipment Exhibition "HEMUS 2018".

High Level Conference "Launch of the European Defence Skills Partnership" – The event will take place on 19 June 2018 in Brussels. Participants from industry, academia and authorities will gather to discuss how to ensure the availability of highly advanced and rapidly changing technological skills for the defence industry; and how the creation of a common European defence skills strategy will contribute to this endeavour.

European forum on defence and dual-use technologies in the maritime domain — Jointly organised by the European Commission and ENDR member Provence-Alpes-Côte d'Azur Region, the ENDR event will take place now in Toulon on 20-21 September 2018 (instead of 24-25 May 2018).
