PESCO 'clarification workshop' held in EDA – On 20/21 September, a 'clarification workshop' at expert level was organized by the PESCO Secretariat at the EDA with the aim of facilitating an exchange of information between the PESCO participating Member States and to provide details on the 33 new project proposals put forward by them as part of the second project assessment.

<u>Industry Consultation Portal</u> – On 01 October EDA launched the Industry Consultation Portal. The main objective of this portal is to collect industry's views to inform the development of the Strategic Context Cases (SCCs), one for each 2018 EU Capability Development Priorities, and contribute to the output orientation of the SCCs.

1st AAR Conference in Europe points at ways to fill capability gap – Some 200 experts, stakeholders, industry representatives and political/military decision-makers from the European, transatlantic and international Air-to-Air Refueling (AAR) community gathered in Brussels for the 1st AAR Conference in Europe organized by the European Defence Agency (EDA).



EDA 3D-printing report and final video now available - The outcome of EDA's project on Additive Manufacturing (AM, better known as 3D printing), launched in 2016, is now available: **a report** on the impact of AM on the defence and **a video** covering the various project activities.



Defence Data 2016-2017 - The European Defence Agency (EDA) collects defence data on an annual basis, and has done so since 2006, in line with the Agency's Ministerial Steering Board Decision of November 2005. The Ministries of Defence of the Agency's 27 Member States (MS) provide the data. EDA acts as a custodian of the data and publishes the aggregated figures in its booklets.
