Subject: Ex-ante publicity notice for the negotiated procedure 22.ISE.NP3.135 - Service Direct Contract "Organisation of First General Conference of the Incubation Forum for Circular Economy in European Defence – Luxembourg"

To whom it may concern

The European Defence Agency (EDA) will shortly launch a call for tenders for the award of the above-mentioned middle-value contract.

Should you be interested in being invited in the above-mentioned call for tenders, please read and follow the instructions below.

## Background information:

In the frame of the Incubation Forum for Circular Economy in European Defence, EDA will organise a conference at the European Convention Center, 4 Pl. de l'Europe, 1499 Luxembourg, Luxembourg. Participants are to be hosted in Luxembourg, providing accommodation and catering services: the location and services provided must be of the highest standard and must contribute to the smooth running of the event and organisational professionalism.

The number of delegates attending the conference is expected to be a minimum of 100 and a maximum of 140 coming from the European Union (EU) Ministries of Defence, European institutions, academia, industry and research technology organisations as well as other international entities.

A management team meeting comprising of at least 35 persons may be held at the contractor's venue on **05**, **06** and **07** September **2022**.

As a result of this procedure, **EDA will select an accommodation venue that** is located **within 1.5-kilometre distance** from the **European Convention Center**, to allow the delegates to reach the venue hosting the conference by walking (or, for attendees needing special assistance, via transportation provided by the hotel, free of charge).

Additionally, EDA will select an accommodation venue that must be able to provide:

#### **Accommodation:**

- **Up to 6 standard single rooms**, including breakfast, for 04 September 2022;
- **Up to 140 standard single rooms**, including breakfast, for 05 and 06 September 2022 [N.B.: check-out on 07 September 2022 is NOT before h. 14:30].

## **Required meeting rooms:**

- ➤ 1 management meeting room: for at least 35 participants, conference table style, for 05/09/2022 (full day), 06/09/2022 (full day) and 07/09/2022 (morning).
- ➤ 1 VIP meeting room: for 10 people for 05/09/2022 (afternoon), 06/09/2022 (full day) and 07/09/2022 (morning).

Further details on the equipment of the meeting rooms (especially IT-related, such as projectors, laptops, cameras, etc) will be provided to those economic operators who express their interest to this call.

# Participation in the negotiated procedure

Participation in EDA's public procurement procedures is open on equal terms to all natural and legal persons coming within the scope of the EU Treaties. When applying the rules of access to the market, it is the country where the tenderer is established which is to be considered. As regards a natural person, it is the State in which the person has his domicile.

EDA procurement procedures are not covered by the WTO Multilateral Government Procurement Agreement (GPA). Tenderers established in third countries (non-EU countries) do not have the right to participate in procurement procedures unless international agreements in the field of public procurement grant them the right to do so. In case there is no such

agreement, or the agreement does not apply to the kind of contracts put out to tender, tenderers of third countries are not entitled to participate.

The relevant international agreements in the field of public procurement are the Stabilization and Association Agreements (SAA) and the European Economic Area Agreement (EEA). Currently, the following countries have signed and ratified the above Agreements and therefore economic operators established in Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, North Macedonia, Albania, Montenegro, Serbia, Kosovo, Bosnia and Herzegovina also have the right to participate in EDA's public procurement procedures.

Selection criteria: necessary capacity to implement the contract Potentially interested economic operators are hereby informed that the following selection criteria will be assessed in the scope of the envisaged negotiated procedure:

This publicity is in no way binding for the EDA. The EDA's contractual obligation commences only upon signature of the contract with the successful tenderer.

Submission of an expression of interest implies acceptance of receiving the invitation to tender by electronic means. It is the tenderer's responsibility to provide a valid e-mail address together with their contact details in the Reply Form and to check their e-mail regularly.
