The European Defence Agency (EDA) will shortly launch a call for tenders for the award of the above-mentioned middle-value contract.

Should you be interested in being invited in the above-mentioned call for tenders, please read and follow the instructions below.

Background information:

In the frame of the **Consultation Forum for Sustainable Energy in the Defence and Security Sector (CF SEDSS)**, EDA will organise a high-level meeting on the topic “Defence and Energy”, **to be held on 08-09 June 2023, in Stockholm (Sweden)**. For the conference to be successful, the location and services provided must be of the highest standard and must contribute to the smooth running of the event and organisational professionalism.

Subject matter of the contract	<p>EDA will organise a <b>high-level meeting</b> in the context of the third phase of the <a href="#"><u>Consultation Forum for Sustainable Energy in the Defence and Security Sector (CF SEDSS III)</u></a> in <b>Stockholm (Sweden) on Thursday, 08 June and Friday, 09 June 2023</b>, under the <b>auspices of the Swedish Presidency of the Council of the EU</b> and <b>hosted by the Ministry of Defence of Sweden.</b></p> <p>The number of delegates attending the conference on <b>08 and 09 June 2023</b> is expected to be a <b>minimum of 80 and a maximum of 100</b>, coming from the EU Ministries of Defence, European institutions, EU Ministries of Energy and Interior.</p> <p>As a result of this procedure, EDA will select a contractor who must be able to provide:</p>

**Accommodation:**

- **Up to 15 standard single rooms** for 06 June 2023, including breakfast;
- **Up to 95 standard single rooms** for 07 and 08 June 2023, including breakfast;
- **Up to 70 standard single rooms** for 09 June 2023, including breakfast.

**Required meeting rooms:**

➤ **1 meeting room for up to 100 delegates:**

- for 08 and 09 June 2023 (from 07:00 to 18:00) the set-up will be:
  - 1 table top for 6 speakers and a speaking podium;
  - the rest classroom style or cabaret (round tables).

- EDA will need to access the meeting room for the preparation from 10:00 to 18:00 (exact time TBC), on 07 June 2023.

➤ **2 breakout meeting rooms for up to 35 delegates (each):**

- for 08 and 09 June (from 07:00 to 18:00) the set-up will be:
  - 1 table top for 4 speakers;
  - the rest in cabaret (round table with 5-6 persons per table).

- EDA will need to access the meeting rooms for the preparation from 10:00 to 18:00 (exact time TBC), on 07 June 2023.

➤ **1 secretariat office:** up to 6-8 people for 07 June (10:00-18:00), and for 08 and 09 June 2023 (07:00-18:00).

➤ **1 conference registration desk and chairs** for 07 June 2023 (18:30-20:00) and 08 June 2023 (08:00-09:00).

Further details on the equipment of the meeting rooms (especially IT-related, such as projectors, laptops, cameras, screens, audio systems and microphones, etc.) will be provided to those economic operators who express their interest to this call.

**Full Catering Service:**

- **1 ice-breaker reception dinner (standing)** for up to 100 persons on 07 June 2023;
- **1 lunch (seated or standing)** for up to 100 persons on 08 June 2023;
- **1 high quality networking dinner** for up to 100 persons on 08 June 2023;
- **1 reception lunch (finger food)** for up to 100 persons on 09 June 2023;
- **3 coffee breaks** for up to 100 persons (2 for 08 June and 1 for 09 June 2023).

**Note:** A minimum of 80 and a maximum of 100 delegates is expected to attend the event.

Participation in the negotiated procedure	<p>Participation in EDA’s public procurement procedures is open on equal terms to all natural and legal persons coming within the scope of the EU Treaties. When applying the rules of access to the market, it is the country where the tenderer is established which is to be considered. As regards a natural person, it is the State in which the person has his domicile.</p> <p>EDA procurement procedures are not covered by the WTO Multilateral Government Procurement Agreement (GPA). Tenderers established in third countries (non-EU countries) do not have the right to participate in procurement procedures unless international agreements in the field of public procurement grant them the right to do so. In case there is no such agreement, or the agreement does not apply to the kind of contracts put out to tender, tenderers of third countries are not entitled to participate.</p> <p>The relevant international agreements in the field of public procurement are the Stabilization and Association Agreements (SAA) and the European Economic Area Agreement (EEA). Currently, the following countries have signed and ratified the above Agreements and therefore economic operators established in Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, North Macedonia, Albania, Montenegro, Serbia, Kosovo, Bosnia and Herzegovina also have the right to participate in EDA’s public procurement procedures.</p>
